When the driver arrives, **you should always ask**

to see a copy of the driver's identity card.

Please copy the **'Customer Use Only'** number from the label on your Parcelforce bag onto your pharmacy receipt and ask the driver to sign for the collection. This will help us if we ever need to track your prescriptions.

If your prescriptions are **not** ready for collection, please contact us immediately to discuss arrangements to get your submissions to **Gyle Square**. This may incur a further collection cost to your pharmacy. In case of any problems or if you need more bags, please call us on **0131 467 7766**.
