- is aimed at pharmacists early in their career who are in patient-focussed roles to encourage them to develop knowledge, skill, values and behaviours to confidently practice in any sector
- has been designed in line with the RPS UK Post-Registration Foundation curriculum
- includes an Independent Prescribing course delivered by a Scottish university after at least 12 months in training
- enables integration to the multidisciplinary team through the need to have collaborators from different professions, review your practice
- requires an Educational Supervisor to undertake regular meetings & review of evidence.

- have an Educational Supervisor before registering
